



SCHOOL UNIFORM POLICY 2026

The school uniform is an essential part of the College identity and is therefore considered to be very important by the College community. Full school uniform is obligatory and must be worn upon entering the school grounds, during school hours, and at school functions. Uniforms should be clean and in good condition. No frayed hems or cuffs on trousers, jumpers or shirts will be allowed.

DAILY UNIFORM

- School Crested Charcoal Grey Jumper for junior year groups (1st - 3rd)
- School Crested Wine Jumper for senior year groups (TY – 6th)
- White Shirt
 - There should be no coloured tee-shirt visible under the shirt
- School Tie
 - Ties must be visible and not hidden under the jumper
- Grey Trousers
 - No Jeans allowed
 - Underwear must not be visible
 - Black belt (if necessary) – no other colour belt is acceptable
- Black Leather non-casual Shoes
 - No other style or colour of footwear is allowed
 - No trainer/sneaker/runner/canvas style shoes whether made of leather or not.
 - No velcro fastenings
 - No white soles
 - No visible sports brand logos
- Black jacket with school crest new or old version permissible, official school suppliers (listed below) will have a stock of each style permissible. Senior students (4th – 6th year) ONLY are allowed to wear a plain black jacket, other than the school jacket. No other colour jacket is allowed.

Please note that no Pres rugby tops/hoodies or any alternative hoodies can be worn during the normal school day in place of the regular daily uniform.

Please note also that school shoes or jackets should not be stored in student lockers, where students wear alternative footwear or jackets into school and then change into the correct uniform. The correct uniform, including footwear and jackets, should be worn upon entering and leaving the school premises.

- White crested polo shirt
- Black crested tracksuit

SPORTS TEAMS

- Rugby Kit – available each September to be purchased through the school
 - White school rugby jersey
 - White crested rugby shorts
 - Pres Bray rugby socks
 - Training top
- Basketball Kit – available through the school in September if playing for school team

RELATED ISSUES

- The wearing of earrings or other facial piercings is not allowed.
- Hairstyles should be neat, tidy and well maintained.
 - No dyed hair
 - Long hair should be tied back and kept neat
- Any visible tattoos will not be tolerated and will be considered to be a breach of the College Code of Behaviour.

SANCTIONS

Any student who is not in full school uniform will incur a sanction as outlined below.

1st Offence – school detention (Friday afternoon or time to be decided by the Yearhead or school management)

2nd Offence – Parents/Guardians will be contacted, and asked to bring in the correct uniform, or the student may be sent home to change into proper school uniform, particularly for correct footwear

3rd Offence – Parents/Guardians will be contacted again, the student may be sent home for the day, and stronger sanctions may also be incurred including Saturday detention or suspension

Repeated offences may result in Parents/Guardians needing to meet with school management before the student is allowed to return to class.

It should be noted that a note or email from Parents/Guardians will no longer suffice if a student is not in correct uniform. If there is a one-off genuine reason for a student not to be in the correct uniform, including the correct footwear, then the Parent/Guardian should contact the Deputy Principal, Mr. Coffey, to offer an explanation, through the school office on 01 2867517.
